HOLY GOD

(THE THRICE-HOLY)

Dobri Christov (1875-1941) was a prominent Bulgarian composer, choral conductor, and pedagogue. Many of the hymns in his *Liturgy of St. John Chrysostom* (Sofia: S. Staikov, n.d.) are based on Bulgarian Chant melodies, including the present setting of *Holy God*.

The English-language edition retains all of the composer's dynamic, tempo, and articulation markings without change.
