
The chanting and singing of God is With Us is part of the Office of Grand Compline, which is served on the eves of the Feasts of the Nativity of Christ, Theophany, and Annunciation, and during the weekdays of Great Lent. The present edition follows the performance scheme found in the chant-book Prazdniki Notnago Peniia (St. Petersburg: Sinodal'naia Tipografiia, 1900), except that the indications for performance by two choirs are omitted. If two choirs are available, each choir repeats the opening chorus and alternates on the refrains; once the verses are finished, the left choir repeats the opening chorus, the right follows with "Glory: God is with us," the left-with "Now and ever: God is with us," and both sing the final refrain "For God is with us."


According to many service-books, however, the entire chorus "God is with us! Understand this, on ations, and submit yourselves, for God is with us," is to be repeated after "Glory:" and after "Now and ever:," concluding with the final refrain "For God is with us."

The harmonization by Aleksandr Andreevich Arkhangelsky (1846-1924) is an example of his strict, archaic style. The chant melody, which in this setting lies entirely in the soprano voice, is taken exactly from the Prazdniki Notnago Peniia.

The present edition is based on the Slavonic original, published during the composer's lifetime. Tempo markings, dynamics, dotted barlines, and auxiliary time signatures, as well as the recitation tones and the refrains, have been added by the editor.
